M.S. "IRINI'S LUCK"

I acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 30th January and note your remarks, which have been reported to the Committee here today.

As already pointed out, the maximum period permitted by the Society's Rules between surveys has already been exceeded, and the Committee therefore find considerably difficulty in agreeing to any further extension. They have, however, authorised me to cable to the Society's Surveyors at Piraeus enquiring whether the parts seen by them in October, 1962, can be regarded as efficient until the ship completes a voyage from Stettin to the Eastern Mediterranean by the end of March, 1963; and, provided the reply is satisfactory, the Committee will not require the ship again to be drydocked at Stettin. They will, however, expect the remainder of the ship to be opened up and drilled afloat as far as may seem necessary to the Surveyors. When the Surveyors are completely satisfied, they will be permitted to issue a Certificate for the proposed voyage.

As regards the machinery, one main air receiver, one auxiliary air receiver and one lubricating oil cooler will require to be seen.

For a Load Line Certificate, it will be necessary for a Load Line Survey to be held in conjunction with the above requirements.

In reply to the enquiry on the second page of your letter, the vessel's class will meantime be maintained until she arrives at a port of discharge; but for any further extension thereafter, the foregoing surveys will be required. I will inform you by telephone of the result of the enquiry that is being made of the Piraeus Surveyors.
