I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 15th instant relative to the steamer "LACKLAN", and with regard thereto I have to refer you to the last report received on this vessel, viz. Bremen No.1021 dated August/September, 1954, and to my classing letter of the 29th October, 1954.

To entitle the vessel to a full Special Survey notation according to our records the following/remains to be carried out:-

Bulkhead stiffeners at transverse bulkheads 43, 46 (tank 9 fwd. and aft), 54, 57 (tank 6 fwd. and aft), 67 (tank 2 aft) and 74 (fwd. cofferdam) to be dealt with as found necessary.

It will be noted that the Boiler Survey will become due at the end of the present month.
