Shellplate D.2 (ss) slightly indented at ford.end.

Shellplate adjacent to and below shellplate E.2 set in at upper edge.

Shellframe No.1 (ss from fore peak bulkhead) buckled over approx. 4 ft.in way of shell plate E.2.

Shellframe No.2 (ss from fore peak bulkhead) buckled over approx.4 ft.in way of shell plate E.2.
