With reference to the telephone conversation of this afternoon regarding the above ship, we shall be glad if you will kindly inform us what arrangements you propose making for leaky bottom shell plating in way of cofferdam between frames 67/68, port and starboard from aft, to be specially examined and dealt with by the end of the present month as recommended by the Sydney Surveyor.

Your intentions to carry out the Main Boiler Survey which becomes due at the end of December next will also be appreciated.

We also take this opportunity to remind you that no reply has yet been received from you to our letter of the 9th March and subsequent reminders respecting the outstanding account, viz. £435,500, for the survey on the "Koei Maru", and your definite arrangements for this account to be settled at an early date are awaited.
