The class is subject to auxiliary feed check valve chest on starboard boiler, water end of ballast pump and condenser discharge valve chest being renewed and suction and delivery valve chest on independent feed pump permanently repaired by 2.46.

LMC due 5.44, partly held previously has now been completely reheld and screwshaft examined.

All conditions above have been dealt with and arrangements for burning oil fuel have been partly carried out.
