
undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owners attend on board the S.S. "PARCORALI" 3727 tons gross of Monrovia whilst vessel lay afloat at Piraeus on the 11th December, 1957 for the purpose of witnessing a test on all cargo derricks.

All derricks port and starboard were placed in a position of 45° to the horizontal for this test, with the head of the derricks extending over the ship's sides.

An overload of 25% was applied and sustained for several minutes during which time the derricks, stays, blocks and shackles were satisfactory.

In the opinion of the undersigned the derricks are suitable for the maximum working load, as marked on the derricks.
