## Motorship "LATIRUS"

The case of the above named vessel has received the consideration of the Committee today in connection with your letter of the 22nd instant. As you are already aware, this ship holds a notation of "Laidup - Special Survey and repairs incomplete", and in view of this, the Committee would not feel justified in issuing a Certificate for the "LATIRUS" to proceed as a fully classed ship.

They are, however, naturally anxious to assist in every way practicable, and if it will be of assistance to you, the Society's Outdoor London Surveyors will be authorised to issue a Certificate for the voyage to Rotterdam as an unclassed ship, provided on inspection the vessel is found to be, in their opinion, satisfactory for this short voyage.

If the vessel is not likely to return from Rotterdam at an early date, it is considered a further inspection should be held in Rotterdam before the ship leaves that port on her return voyage.

If you require a Loadline Certificate to be issued for the above voyage, it will of course be necessary for a Renewal Survey to be held by the London Surveyors.
