A SPECIAL SURVEY (B) became due 9,57.

The class is subject to indented side shell plates E.7 & 8 (p.s.f.) and bulkhead at aft end of No.8 centre cargo tank being dealt with by completion of the Special Survey.

There is an Endorsement of Certificate.

The above survey commenced at Cff. 1,57 by the examination & testing of the fore peak tank also the fore deep tank and the A.P.tank.

In addition to the above the E.R. D.B.tank, fore peak space, chain locker, fore hold and auxiliary pump room were examined.

The CARDIFF Surveyors report ship placed in dry dock and the Special Survey advanced by the examination of the masts and rigging.

To enable the Owners to assess the cost of completing the Special Survey most of the structural members have been drill tested and the results disclose that extensive renewals are required to the ship. The Owners have made arrangements for the ship to be laid up at an early date.

IT IS SUBMITTED the ship is eligible to remain as classed, with record of 'DS 1,58' ~~as~~ assigned as recommended, subject as above, but further ACTION be DEFERRED for completion of the Special Survey.
