Stephenson Clarke Ltd., attend on the S/S "LADY OLGA", 1266 tons gross of London, as she lay afloat at Sunderland, on the 14th and 18th December 1957, prior to the ship, without cargo, being towed from Sunderland to a Belgian Port, in order to examine the hatchways and their closing and securing appliances, also exposed casings, superstructure bulkheads, companionways, ventilator coamings, air pipes, fidley openings and skylights with their closing appliances, which protect openings in freeboard and superstructure decks, and to examine generally about decks, bulwarks, etc..

I will transmit to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping a Report stating that the repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction and that, in my opinion, the ship is in an efficient condition for the contemplated voyage.
