With reference to the Special and Auxiliary Boiler Surveys, which become due at the end of September next, I shall be glad if you will ascertain and let me know what arrangements the Owners propose making for these inspections to be carried out.

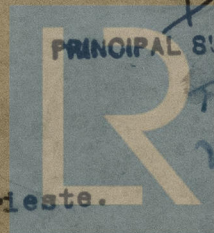
