now altered.

The small tank in the centre of the deep tank in  
No.5 hold is now a part of the deep tank and the capacities  
of this tank and No.6 and 7 tanks are:

Deep tank	1211.24	Tons S.W.
No.6 D.B.	120.16	"
No.7 D.B.	159.12	"

I have to confirm that the No.6 and 7 D.B.tanks  
are now dry tanks, and note that the letters (Dr) included on  
our certificate but unfortunately missed from our report,  
have been assigned.
