Dear Sirs,

E. I have to acquaint you that Mr. E. Pollich has cabled to this Office to the effect that in his opinion four additional air receivers are required for the Motorship "LEONE" and that these are at Leghorn ready to be installed on the ship's arrival there on the 16th instant. These additional air receivers have been made by Messrs. Tosi, but the material used in the construction of them has not been tested.

In the special circumstances the Committee have agreed to accept these air receivers provided their scantlings are in accordance with the Society's Rules, neither Oxy-acetylene nor electric welding has been employed in their construction and the air receivers be satisfactory when tested by hydraulic pressure.
