S. With reference to your letter of the 9th instant returning my classing letter of the 4th instant, I have to point out that the reference made in connection with the cases of the Steamers "ADMIRAL VERNON" and "ATLANTIC" was to two reports Nos. 1944 and 1991 respectively on machinery (Bollinder Oil Engine in the case of the "ADMIRAL VERNON", and Geared Turbines in the case of the "ATLANTIC") which has since been fitted to these vessels.
