With reference to your letter of the 12th instant respecting our First Entry report No. 248 on the s.s. "ATLANTIC" I beg to state, the anchors were tested by a Surveyor to Bureau Veritas; the weights of the stream and kedge anchor stocks and the thicknesses of B. strake of shell, as given on the report, are correct.

I regret that we omitted to state on the report that the Downton pump is fitted in the ship as shown on the approved pumping plan, also that the workmanship and materials are of good quality.

With regard to the scantlings of the shelter deck stringer I have to inform you that the particulars reported are the measured sizes taken from the ship. This material was ordered by the Builders in accordance with the approved scantlings.
