Messrs. G. Geebeck A.G. of Geestemünde tested the steam super-heating arrangement proposed to be fitted in the Vessel No. 18 building at Messrs. the Aktiebolaget Ceresundvarvet, Landskrona. The steel castings have been made at the Atlas-Werke of Bremen and tested in accordance with the requirements of the Society's Rules, and the whole arrangement has been tested in my presence to three times the working pressure, viz. 600 pounds per square inch with satisfactory results.

The name plates of the Manufacturers of the boilers Messrs. the Bremer Vulkan Vegesack are fastened to the headers by copper rivets and bear the identification marks Nos. 240-250, 16 atm, 1920. They have been stamped R on the rivet heads.
