I have surveyed this ship for the purpose of seeing whether the certificate should remain in force, and the survey has been completed to the satisfaction.



 One plate on fidley casing side cropped and part renewed,
 and one plate doubled.
 One plate on fidley top cropped and part renewed.
 14 Hatch battening bars renewed.
 14 Hatch covers and 47 Hatch cleats renewed.
