We refer to your letter of the 29th January and to previous correspondence concerning the above ship in respect of the completion of the Boiler Survey which was recently advanced at Madras, and concerning the arrangements for Special Survey.

We have received, today, a letter from the owners, as follows :-

"In connection with the survey of the Centre boiler of our above vessel, we would request you to kindly permit us to waive the same as the vessel is to be scrapped in the month of March, 1963.

We assure you that the Centre boiler will not be used at any time, steam and feed connections will be blanked off and the boiler man-hole door left open.

We shall arrange for you to inspect the boiler after the above work has been carried out.

The vessel is due to sail from Calcutta about the 12th instant."

We will be visiting this ship during the course of the next day or so to examine the blanking off of the Centre boiler and we will report accordingly in due course.

We understand from the owners that the ship will be scrapped at Bombay, where she is now proceeding from Calcutta.
