Messrs. Brown, Boveri & Co.Ltd., attend at their Works to inspect and witness the tests carried out on one exhaust gas driven pressure charger, type VTR 320, designated No.B.27347, manufactured by them to the order of Messrs. Brown, Boveri & Co.Ltd., Mannheim.

The materials of the rotating parts have been taken from stock tested by the Society's Surveyor and the blower wheel has been overspeeded to 25'000 R.P.M.

At the final mechanical running test the pressure charger was driven at 15'000 R.P.M. for 1/2 hour and at 17'500 R.P.M. for 1/4 hour and when opened up the various parts were found in good order.

To complete the survey a performance test should be carried out with the pressure charger and its prime mover.
