In reply to your letter of yesterday's date regarding the M.V. "ACAVUS" (Belfast Report No.11456) we have to state that the bilge pump installation consists of two rotary pumps 35 tons capacity each, driven by the main engines and one independent bilge pump steam driven 8" x 8" x 10". In addition there is a 50 tons ballast pump in the forward pump room connected to the bilge suctions at the forward end of the vessel.
