

Dear Sir,

We are forwarding herewith Survey Report on the m.v. "ACAVUS", in which reference is made to the temporary repair carried out to the Stern Frame etc.

The following sketches are enclosed :-

1. Transverse bracket connections to longitudinal bulkheads.
2. Temporary repair to Stern Frame.
3. Proposed new upper part of Stern Frame showing suggested amendments.

One of the three approved plans in connection with the Stern Frame which were forwarded with your advice note of the 14th ultimo is returned herewith; the other two were forwarded to London with Mr. Turnbull's letter of the 17th November reporting the fractures in the Stern Frame.
