

"CHRISTIAN", we have to state that the back bars to the shell connections of transverses at bilge are fitted as approved; and that the inner surface of the bottom shell plating in the after peak tank has been protected with cement, (fresh water tank) and in the fore peak tank with bitumastic enamel.

The Builders are preparing a midship section of the vessel as built.
