Steamer "KULANGSU"

In confirmation of my cablegram to you today as per copy herewith, I would inform you that the year of grace for the overdue Special Survey in this instance expired last May, and at the request of the Owners, the Committee agreed in May to the Special Survey being deferred until some time before the end of September provided a General Examination were held with satisfactory results at an early opportunity, and my letter to you on 28th May refers to this subject.

The General Examination was partly held at Hong Kong in June and a short term Load Line certificate valid until the end of July was issued so as to enable the vessel to proceed to your port for the remainder of the General Examination.

It is now noted from your cablegram of yesterday that the Owners' Representatives have requested a Load Line certificate valid until the end of November 1962 and the Committee have today been informed of that fact.

The Committee consider that the extension previously granted should have been amply sufficient to cover the Owners' commitments and in the absence of any specific reason for the Owners' request, they have decided to adhere to their previous decision and to authorise you to issue a certificate valid only until the end of September on satisfactory completion of the present General Examination.
