Steamer "KULANGSU"

A Special Survey fell due on the above-named ship in May 1961 and it is understood she is now loading in North China for your port whence she will proceed to Marmagoa and then Japan where a Special Survey will be held by the end of September next.

As the year of grace for this survey will expire at the end of the present month, the Committee can only agree to the maintenance of the ship's class if a satisfactory General Examination is held after discharge of the cargo in Colombo.

The Owners have been informed accordingly; and the Committee desire you to take every precaution to satisfy yourself that the ship is fit for the proposed deferment, the question of drydocking being left entirely to your discretion.

The Owners have further been informed, through the Hong Kong Surveyors, that the present Load Line certificate will expire on the 31st May and that if a short term certificate is desired it will be necessary for a Load Line Survey to be held in conjunction with the General Examination.
