T.E.S. "HYRCANIA".

We have to acknowledge your letter of the  
ultimo, together with Hull and Machinery  
Classification Certificates, for which we are  
grateful, and your remarks have been noted for  
reference.

With regard however, to your notation that  
classification assigned is subject to 30 fathoms  
main cable being supplied, we find that according  
to our records, 2 new lengths each of 15½ fathoms  
were supplied by Messrs. Harry Cocks & Co. of Cardiff,  
and placed on board the vessel at Birkenhead whilst  
undergoing repairs and remeasurement, etc., during  
January/March, 1948.

In this connection, it is observed that Lloyd's  
Classification Certificates were numbered 17096/97.

For your further information, whilst the "HYRCANIA"  
was being surveyed in the River Tyne in July last, the  
cables were ranged in drydock, and we were given to understand  
by our Marine Superintendent he was informed by Lloyd's  
Surveyor, who was present, that the cables were in order.

In due course, perhaps you will be good enough to  
acknowledge our observations hereon.
