

Motorship "ONDINA"

A report has been received from the Society's Yokohama Surveyors of a survey held in December and January last, from which it is noted the ship was examined in drydock, the Donkey Boiler and Steam Pipe Surveys held, and the screwshaft drawn and examined.

The low sea injection valve chest was found to be wasted, and the class of the ship has accordingly been made subject to this valve chest being renewed before the end of January, 1959.

Fresh records of Docking Survey, Donkey Boiler Survey, Steam Pipe Survey, and Tailshaft Survey, with a date of 1/58, have been assigned.
