I am advised by Mr. Buchanan that the plans listed in his First Entry Report relating to the new forebody fitted in the above named vessel were sent to you in order that the name of the ship and report number may be inserted and the plans forwarded with the report. Up to date, these plans have not come to hand and these should be dispatched immediately in order that they may follow the report.

It is noted that in the Rpt. 8 no entry is made regarding the verification of the freeboard, but since a revised freeboard was assigned to the vessel and you verified it, the figures should have been inserted. It is also noted that no reference is made in Rpt. 8 to the renewal of the forward part of the ship and it is suggested that after the word "renewed" in the fifth line of repairs, you might add the words "forward part of the vessel completely rebuilt - See Rpt. 1". I should like your concurrence in order that the London office may be informed.

It has been thought well to amend the fees shown on the First Entry report thus:
