


"NEUVA ANDALUCIA"

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This motor tanker was built by the Deutsche Werft, Hamburg, for the Texas Company A/S, of Oslo, and was handed over to the Owners just before the occupation of Norway.

No entry has been made in the Register Book in respect to this vessel.

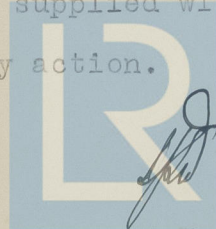
A report of a damage survey held by the New York Surveyors has been transmitted to the Committee for consideration.

The case is very similar to that of the "SKANDINAVIA", in which it was decided that the distinguishing mark , indicating that the vessel has been built under the special survey of the Society's Surveyors, should be omitted from the vessel's class 100A1 "Carrying Petroleum in bulk".

It is submitted that, as in the previous similar case, arrangements should be made for the tanker to be generally examined by the Society's Surveyors and, with this in view, a draft First Entry Report, which has been prepared in this Office in the absence of a First Entry Report, should be forwarded to the Surveyors in order that the scantlings and arrangements indicated thereon may be verified for the assignment of the class.

When verified, the pencilled entries should be filled in in ink and the completed report forwarded to this Office for consideration.

As the executive of the Owners is in America, the New York Office should be instructed and supplied with the draft report with a view to their taking the necessary action.
