

It appears that only a small part of the Special Survey received attention at Naples in February, 1957, and it is not felt that the fact of the ship having been laid up between July 1956 and February last has any material bearing on the point at issue. The major part of the Special Survey was held at Trieste in July, 1956 (Trieste report No. 14439), and I shall be much obliged if you will kindly give consideration to this case to see if there is likely to be any other course of action which may commend itself to the Owners. Alternatively perhaps you will kindly advise the Naples Surveyors of our decision.
