Motorship "OVULA"

With reference to Singapore Rpt. No. 12884, with enclosed plans showing the thicknesses of shell, decks, bulkheads and internals, I would acquaint you that the recommended shell and deck renewals have been indicated on the plans submitted. The plans forwarded by you are enclosed, and I shall be glad if you will return only the plans of shell and deck plating to this Office' after due note has been made of the necessary renewals.

The repairs to the wasted internal structure should be dealt with by you on the occasion of the Special Survey in accordance with previous instructions given in similar cases, and I would add, for your general guidance, that where the thicknesses of the individual internal items are reduced by approximately 30% of the original thickness they should be renewed.
