Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter of the 28th ultimo returning the list showing the particulars of refrigerating appliances used in your fleet, and would thank you for your attention in the matter.

The queries you raise have been investigated and as regards the "MARTIN BAKKE", "ELISABETH BAKKE" and "MARGRETHE BAKKE", we find that reports of the supplementary machines now in use in these ships were received in this Office in 1938 but that no report was ever received of their installation.

Provided, however, the Society's Surveyors be afforded an opportunity of ascertaining that these supplementary machines have been fitted on board in accordance with the Rules, we shall be pleased to amend the particulars in the Register Book as requested.

As regards the "SOFIE BAKKE", "KNUT BAKKE" and "OLAV BAKKE", I have to say that the figures shown in the Register Book for the ice melting capacity will be amended to 73 tons.

I would add that copies of this correspondence are being sent to the Oslo and Bothenbug Surveyors and you will doubtless be able to make detailed arrangements with them for the cases to receive attention as indicated above.
