Motorship "LOYOLA"

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 4th instant, the contents of which have been noted.

The Report of the Survey held at Cartagena last month has now been before the Committee who have continued the Class of the Machinery of this ship, subject to :

- (1) The exhaust gas boiler not being used until surveyed.
- (2) Both main engine jacket fresh water coolers being specially examined by April 1962.
- (3) Main engine No. 4 unit column head flange being examined on the starboard side in way of a crack and dealt with by February 1962.

I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners of these conditions of Class and, at the sametime, ascertain and let me know what arrangements they propose to make in regard to the Donkey Boiler Survey which will become due at the end of this month.
