Theodor Zeise, Altona, attend at their works at Altona-Ottensen, on the 6th October, 1936, for the purposes of testing and inspecting of one solid bronze four bladed propeller of 3800 mm diameter, to the order of Messrs. Materiel - Kontoret, Oslo, and intended for their Yard No. 881.

Samples taken from the material showed the following Results:-

Diameter of Sample	14.1	mm
Tensile strength	49.2	kg/mm^2
Gauge length	50.0	mm
Elongation	27.0	%

Band Tests good.

On examination this casting as far as could be seen, was found to be sound and free from surface defects and the workmanship to be satisfactory.
