Postponement of Special Survey - S.S. "CLAUS BISCHOFF"

I refer to the telephone conversation with Mr. Cordes, Hamburg, and would like to advise you that the above ship has been sold to Italy for breaking up.

The ship shall make the last voyage with a cargo of timber from Finland to Monfalcone/Italy. The postponed special survey of this ship is due in April, 1962. I can only take over the said cargo in Finland by the end of April/beginning of May. It is not yet known to me how long the loading will take. In any case the voyage will not be completed before the middle or end of June.

Thus I kindly ask you to postpone the special survey until the end of June, 1962.

P.S. The repairs to the forward end plate knuckle at centre furnace of the starboard boiler will be presented for survey by the end of April. The ship will probably pass the Canal (Kiel-Canal) at the end of April. I shall advise you in good time of the exact date, in order that the inspection may be carried out then.
