Steamer "LUCANIA"  
"Overdue SS 6.57 Incomplete"

The case of this ship has received the consideration of the Committee, and although it is noted that a part Drilling Special Survey was carried out at Genoa in May, 1958, a second four-yearly Special Survey period has elapsed since the last date of survey recorded in the Register Book. In these circumstances and in the absence of any proposal in dealing with the overdue surveys, the Committee feel that they would not be justified in continuing the class of this ship.

They have, therefore, given instructions for a record to be made in the Register Book indicating that the class has been withdrawn, and I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners accordingly.
