With reference to your classing letter of the 20th instant respecting our first entry report No. 22439 on the Motortug "ZWARTE ZEE", I have to state that the vessel has been built in accordance with the plan of midship section approved 8-10-32, a copy of which is being retained in your office for record, the deviations as regards frame spacing and thickness of framing and shell plating have been embodied in my report and are those originally given by the Builders on the plan in excess of your requirements.

The extreme breadth over the belting is 33.25 feet.
