Steamer "REDRIFF".

Reverting to our letter of the 17th June, regarding the First Entry Report, we beg to advise you that the alterations in the vessel having now been completed, the report is being forwarded to-day (under its original No. 79285).

The classification fees as regards the Hull were applied for on the 12th June and paid by the Shipbuilders on the 11th July, these being calculated upon the gross tonnage which had been assigned to the vessel when first completed. In consequence, however, of certain minor alterations on board, an adjustment has been made by the Board of Trade in the gross tonnage, this being increased from 1547 to 1556.

We presume that, in the circumstances, it will not be considered necessary for the Builders to be approached in respect of the additional fee of 9/- due under the Society's Rules, but otherwise we should be glad to receive your instructions in the matter.
