Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in Newcastle, October 1947.

After Accommodation.

Centre poop deckhouse has been extended by moving the deckhouse front up to the after coaming of the Tonnage hatch.

The companionway, port side, to the tween deck accommodation has been modified and 2 watertight doors have been fitted, 1 in tonnage well bulkhead, and 1 in the bulkhead at fore end of the poop accommodation. Watertight doors and steel companionway door capable of being operated from both sides.

Sidelights in poop accommodation have been renewed with 11" dia. sidelights, soundly constructed and fitted with deadlights.

2 additional 6" dia. cowl ventilators to the poop accommodation have been fitted on the shelter deck. Wood plugs and canvas covers are provided. Coamings 30" x 38".
