

Dear Sir,

In reply to your classing letter of the 19th. instant regarding the "FORT BRUNSWICK" (Newport Rpt. No.24907), we have to state that the inspection and hose-testing of the shell riveting, as reported, was carried out with full knowledge and confirmation of the comments contained in London Rpt. No.111575.

As thorough hose-testing revealed only slight dampness at a few scattered rivets, it is considered that the shell riveting is satisfactory.

Regarding the slightly indented shellplate G6 (p.s.) it is considered that this need not be noted against the vessel. It is regretted that this statement was not made on the report as intended.
