After carefully reviewing all the facts the Committee consider that the circumstances regarding classification should be clear to all concerned by the notation which at present appears against the ship's name in the Register Book, namely "Repairs required - ~~last~~ suspended 1.64" and they have therefore decided to take no further action for the present, but of course to leave this notation as it at present appears.
