If this is the case a notation of "Fitted for oil fuel 8,55 FP above 150°F" will be assigned. A record of sps 8,55 will also be assigned in respect of the Steampipe Survey carried out at this time.

It is concluded that there is no evaporator on this ship, but your confirmation is desired. At the same time I shall be glad to learn the thicknesses of the upper deck plating, as ascertained by drilling. An early reply will be appreciated.
