Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 9th instant forwarding an outline profile and deck plan for an open shelter deck vessel, for which Messrs. P. Smit Jr. are negotiating, and with regard thereto I send herewith a preliminary assignment letter setting forth the freeboards assigned.

At the same time I have to confirm my telegram to you today as follows:-

Smit Jr. proposed vessel  
GYKUSGWYPA - provisional freeboard. The freeboard assigned is 0'-11 $\frac{1}{2}$ " from top of statutory deck line to centre of disc  
GWYWYGYDTA - The statutory deck line is 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " above steel deck at side. Fresh water 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ "  
GYDZUGYFVA - Indian summer 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Winter 3"  
GYGXEMIHNH - Winter North Atlantic 5" subject  
KUSZUGYKOR - letter follows compulsory freeboard
