SOURCE OF INFORMATION

MARIA VERONICA.—London, May 22.—The following message has been received from the owner of motor vessel Maria Veronica, dated Santiago, Chile, May 21: Communicated Saturday night (May 19) vessel wrecked and totally lost north of Los Vilos.

MARIA VERONICA. — Santiago, Chile, May 23. — Motor vessel Maria Veronica struck submerged rock and subsequently ran ashore to avoid sinking due to inflow of water. Vessel on rocks, reported breaking up. Cargo being washed ashore. In view of remoteness of wreck, have arranged to photograph it from the air for study by our surveyor.—Lloyd's Agents per Salvage Association. (See issue of May 23.)

MARIA VERONICA. — Valparaiso, May 29.—Motor vessel Maria Veronica: Attempted beaching Punta Talquilla on May 19. After visiting spot with surveyor, find vessel hold (? held) aft and aft weather deck submerged to amidships house. Impossible to board due to rocks and seas breaking over wreck. Consider constructive total loss.—Lloyd's Agents per Salvage Association. (See issue of May 25.)
