

Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in

- (1) Tonnage opening on the shelter deck, freeing ports in tonnage well and all overboard scuppers, including tonnage well now permanently closed.
Partly done at London and Swansea.
- (2) All sanitary discharges from spaces below the shelter deck now fitted with screw down, automatic non-return valves controlled from the shelter deck.
- (3) Suitable provision made for lifelines for the use of crew in the regular working of the ship.
- (4) The watertight bulkheads do not extend to the shelter deck, suitable scupper pipes have been fitted on each side of vessel and are in a position to drain freely from all parts of the tween decks.
- (5) The condition of the vessel is good. Hatchway closing appliances and other openings in the tween decks are now efficient.


