Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in February, 1943.

Two extra fiddley openings cut at after side of funnel; fitted with hinged steel covers which are permanently attached.

One extra scupper fitted from gully over steering gear house in poop; discharge at starboard side approximately three feet above foreward deck fitted with fabricated steel and galvanized storm valve which is always accessible.
