Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines
in

GUNNERS ACCOMMODATION.

The Tonnage opening at the aft end of Bridge Space (Port Side) has been
plated over and Gunners Accommodation has been fitted in Tween Decks
at Aft End (Port Side)

3 sidescuttles in Bridge Side plating each with hinged deadlights of
substantial construction

1. W.C. discharge overboard through shell above Freeboard Deck fitted with Storm Valve

1. Scupper discharge overboard, below Freeboard Deck, fitted with Screw Down
plug at inner end.

1. W.B. discharge overboard through shell, above Freeboard Deck, fitted with
Storm Valve.

3. 6" dia vents, 30" coaming; fitted on Bridge Deck to Accommodation,
with wood plugs and canvas covers for closing appliances.

A steel companionway has been fitted on Aft side hatch to Bunker Tween Decks
fitted with wood door capable of being closed from both sides.
