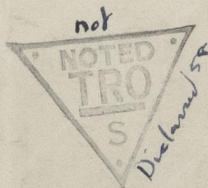
With further reference to your letter of the 14th February last relative to the equipment of the three Bull Line Steamers "ELLENOR", "ELIZABETH" and "LILLIAN", I think it well to say that the complements of anchors and cables of these vessels have now been examined and reports have been submitted to the American Committee, recommending that the condition against their class in this respect be removed.

It was a matter of considerable difficulty to identify the markings owing to them not having been very heavily stamped, but after considerable trouble we were able to have them all cleared up.
