I am in receipt of your letter of January 15th, 1923 on subject of the chain cables and anchors of the vessels "ELLENOR" "ELIZABETH" recently purchased by Messrs A.H. Bull & Co. The chain cables and anchors were ranged in dry dock and examined by me in consequence of the intended re-classification of these vessels, were found to be in accordance with the Rules as to diameter length--being 2" diameter and 270 fathoms in length.

As previously stated, no certificates were produced when examination was made and I doubt very much if the cables could be verified with certificates as the stamping on links is practically worn or rusted out, making identification almost impossible.

Under these circumstances, I think we are justified in stating this matter before the Committee for their favorable consideration.
