- Nos. 2, 3, 4, 6 & 7 cylinder jackets.
- Nos. 2, 3, 4, 6 & 7 piston & rings.
- Nos. 2, 3, 4, 6 & 7 liner extensions and super charge casings.
- No. 7 crosshead and crank pins together with bearings.
- Nos. 1, 5 & 8 water jackets tested and cylinder heads examined.
- The bolt between Nos. 3 & 4 cylinder heads, port side renewed.
- Stand by lubricating oil pump in its entirety.
