"SKANSEN", I think it well to state that the First Entry Report on this vessel was despatched by our previous mail and the fees were sent by the Builders before the Stockholm Surveyors had received our instructions. In these circumstances, and as the fees were in respect of work carried out before the vessel's name was placed on the Statutory List, the fees have been accepted and passed into the Society's account.
