Dear Sir,

We have to refer to our Report No.105241 on the Motorship "AROS" (Messrs. Blyth Dry Docks & Shipbuilding Co's Yard No.334), and to acquaint you that, in accordance with the usual practice, we credited the Copenhagen Surveyors with 1/5th of the fee for the survey of the Electrical Installation. We are now advised by the Copenhagen Surveyors that in cases of this nature they always charge a separate fee against the Makers of the generators who also pay their travelling expenses.

We propose to leave this matter unaltered in this instance and in future similar cases where electrical machinery is partly surveyed at Copenhagen to refrain from crediting that Port with any portion of the fee. We shall be glad to receive any remarks you may have to make on this point.
